Draft Minutes

May 5, 2010

Present: Tom Kenyon, Glenn Seward, Patrick Ross (Agency of Natural Resources), Martha Harrison

- 1) Call to Order – Selectboard Chair Glenn Seward called the meeting to order at 9:10 AM.
- 2) Site visit to Beaver Brook – The Selectboard, the Zoning Administrator, and Patrick Ross went to look at the erosion on the west bank of Beaver Brook, behind the church.
- 3) Discuss erosion mitigation options – Patrick agreed with the suggested placement of two or three large stones across the west branch of the brook to encourage the stream to flow into the east branch. Patrick also suggested that the two ash trees be removed, with the stumps left in the ground. Patrick and the Selectboard agreed that the eroding bank should be stabilized with type II stone, keyed into the brook bed as well as on the stream bank. The slope above the stone should be sloped back and stabilized by planting. The area to be armored is approximately 100 feet long. Patrick gave the Selectboard a stream alteration permit application to fill out and submit along with a sketch plan of the proposed project.
- 4) Silver Hill Road trees – Not discussed
- 5) Adjourn – The meeting was adjourned by consensus at approximately 9:30 AM.
