Ancient Roads; Deb Mithoefer gave her report on her findings on the old road from Sheddsville to Woodstock. She found records from 1815 when the road was altered to its present location. It was agreed that the road is documented enough to not fall into the “unidentified corridor” category. A goal was set to have the road on the map by July 2010. Comments and questions were taken from guests attending. It was suggested by Ted Siegler that when all of the research is complete that we go to the town with the suggestion to have these records digitalized for future reference. Many of the records remain in the town of Windsor and we only have photocopies of them.

Files; Sue Greenall reported on the contents of the WWCC file cabinet and it was decided to give the Baskin Farm records to the WWHS. Copies of all trail easements in WW are now filed. Copies of all conservation easements in WW should be included. Sue will attend to that.

Easements; Bernatchez easement; the easement was not signed, more work needs to be done on wording. Greenall easement language was discussed and suggestions asked for. UVLT will review the language in the next week. Copies will be sent to all WWCC members for review.

New members; Klaus Lubbe declined a position on the WWCC. Laura Stillson expressed interest on coming on the board as has Amber Morse. Ted will write a letter to the selectboard suggesting these two candidates to fill the empty seat.

New Business; Barbara Gerstner expressed interest in vernal pool mapping as did Cathy Boedtkner. Sue will follow up and get information to them when it is available. The Silver Hill Road alteration was discussed and decided that a member of the WWCC should attend the site meeting and public forum on February 22, 2010.
