

WEST WINDSOR SELECTBOARD

Draft Minutes

August 9, 2011

Present: Glenn Seward, Tom Kenyon, Tom Marsh (Windsor Town Manager)

- 1) Call to Order – Selectboard Chair Glenn Seward called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM.
- 2) Meet with Windsor Town Manager to discuss issues of mutual interest – Glenn mentioned some common issues such as the sewer line, the closing of the resort, and the regional police force concept. Tom Marsh talked about his experiences with cooperation among neighboring towns. There was discussion about the status of the sewer line from the resort to Windsor, the status of the resort itself, and the recreational trail concept, including required permits. There was discussion about some of the challenges facing Windsor, including infrastructure maintenance and equipment replacement. There was also discussion about the regional police force concept. Glenn asked Tom Marsh if Windsor would be interested in applying for a joint municipal planning grant to plan for recreational trail expansion in both towns. Tom Marsh asked Glenn to send some more information. There was discussion about some of the positive aspects (e.g. the “Vermont” brand) and negative aspects (e.g. resistance to change) of Vermont. Ideas for improvements in both towns (e.g. renovation of historic structures) were also discussed.
- 3) Adjourn – The meeting adjourned by consensus at approximately 9:30 AM.
