

West Windsor Selectboard  
Draft Minutes  
July 17, 2013

Present at the Act 250 hearing on Land Use Application #2SO397-6C were VT Commissioners Michael Bernhardt, Stephan Morse and Deborah Hallet, and District 2 Coordinator April Hensel. Representing West Windsor were Selectboard Chair Glenn Seward, Selectboard member Bruce Boedtker, Town Attorney Matthew Birmingham, and A&E Engineers Kevin Camara and Nate Pion. Todd Enright represented Snowdance. Jason Rasmussen represented the Southern Windsor County Regional Planning Commission. Town Manager Tom Marsh represented the Town of Windsor. Jeff Nelson and Attorney Nate Stearns represented the Mt. Ascutney Property Owners Association.

The meeting was called to order @ 9:30 AM at 100 Mineral Street in Springfield, VT. All parties were sworn in by Mr. Bernhardt. Mr. Bernhardt stated the commission was not interested in the technical aspects of the application but interested in the issues between all parties. Mr. Birmingham presented a brief history of the situation from July 2010 to the present.

Mr. Seward requested that the commission transfer the permit without conditions. Discussion took place among all parties relating to the transfer of the existing escrow account to the town, the dissolution of Windsor-Ascutney Sewage Treatment Enterprise (WASTE), and ownership issues related to the "upper loop" portion of the system.

Mr. Bernhardt recessed the hearing at 10:33 for approximately 10 minutes. The hearing resumed with Mr. Bernhardt polling all parties regarding any objections to the permit transfer to the Town of West Windsor with no conditions. All parties indicated there were no objections. Mr. Bernhardt stated the permit would be transferred as requested with no conditions.

The meeting adjourned at 10:43 AM.
